

## NMAT(C) B Com (Hons.) & BBA -2010 Analysis

This year's NMAT (C) for B.Com (Hons.) & BBA Programme entrance examination had three sections –

1. Quantitative and numerical ability
2. Reasoning and General Intelligence
3. Proficiency in English Language

Each question carried one mark and there was 0.25 negative marking for every wrong answer. Each question had five options to choose from. The total time allocated for 120 questions was 120 minutes

The overall break up of the paper was as follows:

<b>Section</b>	<b>Number of questions</b>	<b>Marks</b>
Quantitative and numerical ability	40	40
Reasoning and General Intelligence	40	40
Proficiency in English Language	40	40

### **Section wise analysis:**

#### **Proficiency in English language**

The split up of the questions in the English section was as follows:

RC Passage based questions: 1 RC passage

Paragraph filling based question: 10

Synonyms based questions: 3

Antonyms based question: 3

Para jumble based questions: 6 questions based on one set of six sentences

Grammar based question (Find the error based): 5

The level of difficulty of this section was EASY.

#### **Quantitative and Numerical ability**

Most questions were from Arithmetic, Permutation & Combination, Probability, BODMAS and Data Interpretation based (2 sets of questions on tables). The overall difficulty level of this section was moderate.

#### **Reasoning and General Intelligence**

This section had questions from Syllogisms, (5 to 6 questions)

Statement conclusion, Coding Decoding, Data Sufficiency, Analytical reasoning (case-let and arrangement based questions), Mathematical reasoning (symbols based questions) and normal Logical reasoning based questions. The overall difficulty level of this section was difficult.

Overall, students found it much easier than the SET BBA paper. They also felt that our material was good enough to all that came in the test. The overall cut-off of the paper was 80+.
